

ARTICLE II
Parking Regulations

§ 287-7. DEFINITIONS:

IN THIS ARTICLE, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED:

- A. BUS – EVERY MOTOR VEHICLE EXCEPT SCHOOL BUSES, DESIGNED FOR CARRYING MORE THAN TEN (10) PASSENGERS AND USED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS; AND EVERY MOTOR VEHICLE, OTHER THAN A TAXICAB, DESIGNED AND USED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS FOR COMPENSATION.
- B. HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLE – ANY MOTOR VEHICLE AND TANDEM AXLE TRAILER OR SEMITRAILER DESIGNED AND USED FOR CARRYING FREIGHT OR MERCHANDISE OR USED IN FURTHERANCE OF ANY COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE THAT HAS:

A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT (GVW) OF MORE THAN 10,000 POUNDS;

A MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY OF MORE THAN 1 TON;
A LENGTH OF MORE THAN 21 FEET MEASURED FROM THE EXTREMES OF THE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ANY OBJECT LOADED ON THE VEHICLE; OR

A HEIGHT OF MORE THAN 8 FEET WITH PROPERLY INFLATED TIRES, MEASURED FROM THE GROUND TO THE HIGHEST PART OF THE VEHICLE, INCLUDING RACKS, BUT NOT ANTENNAS.

A HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLE DOES NOT INCLUDE A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED BY THE COUNTY OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR A FARM MACHINE OR VEHICLE USED FOR AGRICULTURE.
